

Mission

Child Advancement Centre dedicates to providing early education and training programmes for children with special needs, aged 0 to 6, in a safe, comfortable and enriched learning environment. Being child-centered, family-focus and emphasizing community inclusion, our Child Advancement Centre strives to satisfy children's multi-faceted needs for growth by supporting and enabling parents, guardians and family members to accept, understand, care for and train their children, as well as encouraging community participation.

Objectives

- Special Child Care Centre Service:** to provide centre-based intensive training and care for moderately and severely disabled pre-school children with an aim to assist them in their development and growth. A good foundation is laid for them to get prepared for primary education.
- Early Education & Training Centre Service:** to provide a variety of day pre-school rehabilitation service to meet the varied needs of disabled children from birth to 2 years of age and their family, and also training service to disabled children aged from 2 to 6 who are not concurrently receiving other pre-school rehabilitation services with an aim to assist the children in integrating into the mainstream education.
- Occasional Child Care Service for Disabled Children:** to provide a safe venue for parents or carers to place their children for temporary care so as to enable them to attend to personal or urgent matters. A risk of leaving children alone at home is minimised.
- Extended Hours Service:** to answer the needs of parents who have occasional needs for longer hours of service and avoid leaving children alone at home.

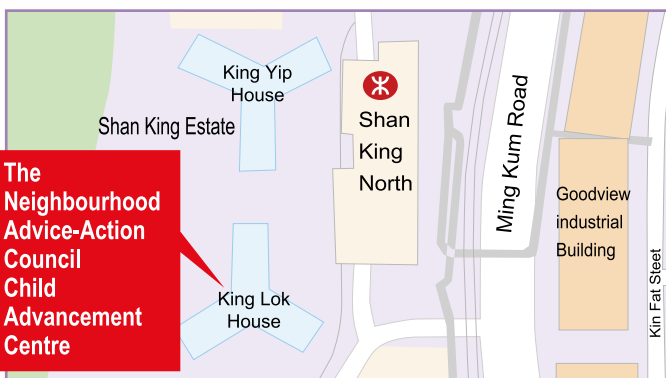

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Target



1. Special Child Care Centre Service

Children aged from 2 to 6 with developmental disabilities (moderate/severe mental handicap, moderate/severe physical handicap, deaf, blind or autism). Priority will be given to families with social needs.

2. Early Education and Training Centre Service

Children from birth to 6 years of age with developmental disabilities and are not receiving other pre-school rehabilitation services.

3. Extended Hours Service

Only for children of our Special Child Care Centre Service. Priority will be offered to those families with social needs.

4. Occasional Child Care Service

Children aged from 2 to 6 with developmental disabilities and siblings of our service users.

Please note that services in this centre currently are only available in Chinese language. If you are in need of English services for a child with special needs, please contact us for a referral.

Support Services

1. Family Support and Network

Talks, workshops and gatherings are regularly organized to encourage parents' participation and to strengthen their capacity in caring and training their children. We promote sharing among care-givers and foster supporting networks among families.

2. Community Inclusion

Enrich children's lives and social experiences through regular community interaction and integration programmes.

3. Occasional Child Care Service and Extended Hours Service

Occasional Child Care and Extended Hours Service allow care-givers to have a short-term and temporary relief in order to reduce child care stress.

Developmental Needs Assessment by Professionals

Our multi-disciplinary team is composed of a group of professionals including a registered Social Worker, a Physiotherapist, an Occupational Therapist, a Speech Therapist, a Nurse and Special Child Care Workers. With the cooperation of parents, case conferences will be held regularly to develop an Individualized Education Plan for each child.

1. Developmental Needs Assessment by Professionals

Our multi-disciplinary team carries out an integrated assessment for each child, which includes sensorimotor abilities, motor abilities, language development, social skills, social adaptation, self-care abilities and nursing care needs. Assessment results will be used as a reference to generate the Individualized Education Plan.

2. Environmental Learning Approach of Training

Our Centre utilizes an Environmental Learning Approach, which emphasizes learning through what is seen, heard and felt in the context of daily life. Development of cognitive skills, motor abilities, language, social skills, emotional expression and adaptation to different environments and culture will be enhanced through the approach.

3. Therapeutic Services

Our Physiotherapist, Occupational Therapist and Speech Therapist provide individual and group training to children, which improve their motor, sensorimotor and language abilities.

4. Nursing Care

Our Nurse coordinates children's health programmes, such as caring guidance, health management and weight monitoring, etc, which aim to monitor children's physical condition, growth and nutrition.

Application

Application will be sent to our centre through Central Referral System for Rehabilitation Services (CRSRehab) of the Social Welfare Department, which receives referral from Child Assessment Centers (CACs) of the Department of Health, hospitals, medical clinics, family service centres, clinical psychologists, medical officers and social workers. Application of Extended Hours Service or Occasional Child Care Service can be made directly through our social worker.

Withdrawal Procedure

Children could withdraw from our services by giving one-month notice to our centre-in-charge/ social worker, in person or by written.

In general situation, termination of service occurs while:

- The child's ability is age-appropriate, or has been enrolled in other subvented pre-school training services e.g. Special Child Care Centre/Early Education and Training Centre/On-site Pre-school Rehabilitation Service/Integrated Programme in Kindergarten cum Child Care Centre
- Child aged 6 or promoted to primary one placement
- If there are any special cases or needs, applicants could contact our social worker in person for termination of service and referral of other suitable training services
