Service missions

About our service

Case management and counseling service

Professional social workers will assist elders and their caretakers in handling personal emotions, housing, economical and general well-being challenges.

Support programme for needy elders and carers

Provides training on how to take care of elders, as well as building a support network via group activities to alleviate the stress on caretakers. (Refer to the elderly carers support programme for more details)

Support for hidden elders

Mobilizing communal resources to identify and provide support to Hidden Elders and involve them into the support network.

Development of volunteer services

Participate actively in the development of volunteer service, and reach the goal of 'Engage your Silver Age with vitality'.

Apply for Long-term care (LTC) services

Ascertain the care needs of elders for applying the Standardized Care Need Assessment Mechanism by using 'MDS-HC).

Care referral and counseling service

In case necessary, the centre will assist with referring the case to appropriate parties and/or organizations.

Events to promote healthy living

Events and seminars centered around the theme of healthy living to help elders get into the right habits.

Social and educational activities

A variety of events to encourage elders to continuously learn and explore new things to add colours to life.
