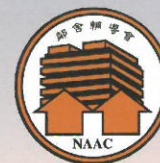

Aims and Objectives

THE NEIGHBOURHOOD ADVICE-ACTION COUNCIL WONGTAISIN DAY ACTIVITY CENTRE has been operating since 1st March 1994.

- Provide tailor-made and quality services to meet individual needs.
- Provide comprehensive services for service users including nursing care, independent living skill training, interpersonal training, interest and potential development.
- Provide education and support services to families in order to release their stress and enable them to encounter challenges.
- Organize various integrated activities to increase public acceptance towards people with disabilities, and enable them to participate in the community.

Service Application and Withdrawal

- Referrals can be made by social workers to the Central Referral System for Rehabilitation Services of the Social Welfare Department.
- Day Activity Centre Service will be terminated when the service user is admitted to residential services or other referrals.
- The service user can withdraw from the service when the services provided by our centre are unable to meet their needs. Follow up service and referrals will be arranged upon request.

Service Content

To fulfill individual learning needs, our centre provides group and individual training as well as outdoor activities in the following areas :

Training and Developmental Service

- Motor Skill Capability
- Self-Care Capability
- Communication Capability
- Domestic Living Capability
- Community Living Capability
- Work Capability
- Leisure Skill and Interest Development
- Social and Interpersonal Capability
- Health and Sex Education



Social Inclusion Service

The following programs are organized to enhance public's awareness and acceptance toward people with disabilities :

Parent Support Service

- Training workshops for families in order to strengthen their caring ability and help them to relieve pressure.
- Opportunity to visit different service units to enhance knowledge of resources and social services available.
- Meetings and activities for families to develop mutual support network and communication with our centre.

Rehabilitation and Caring

- Provide on-going health checks and records for all service users.
- Organize health talks.
- Provide daily nursing and caring service.
- Provide Agency-based Occupational Therapy Services.
