

Service Objectives

- Day Activity Centre cum Hostel for Severely Mentally Handicapped Persons: (1) to provide day care and training in daily living skills and simple work skills. It trains them to become more independent in their daily lives, and prepares them for better integration into the community or for transition to other forms of service or care. (2) provide home living for who lack basic self-care skills and require assistance in personal and nursing care.
- Extended Care Program: to provide day care service to service users who no longer benefit from prolonged or intensive training and are more suitable to enjoy their life through developmental and social activities.
- Residential Respite Service: to provide short-term residential care service for people with disabilities in the community so that their family members or carers in need can have a planned short break or may attend to their personal business.

Target Group

- Day Activity Centre cum Hostel for Severely Mentally Handicapped Persons: people aged 15 or above with severe intellectual disability; not bed-ridden or requiring infirm care; and without severe aggressive behavior endangering self and others.
- Extended Care Program of the Day Care Centre: people aged 50 or above who are existing service users of the Centre, assessed by the Standardised Assessment for Residential Services for People with Disabilities to be eligible for Hostel for Severely Mentally Handicapped Persons or Care and Attention Home for Severely Disabled Persons service.
- Residential Respite Service: PWDs person aged 6 or above and those are willing and suitable for communal living.

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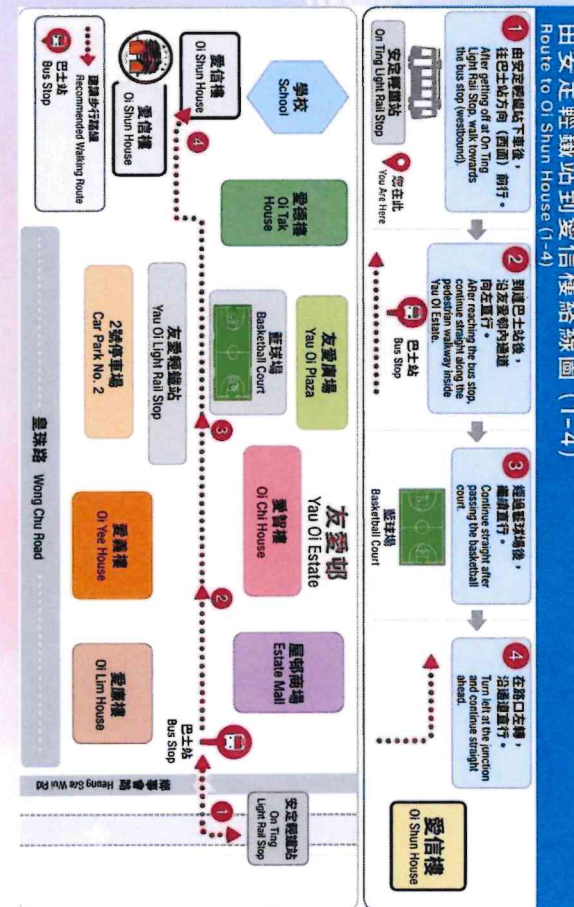

Scope of Service

Day Care Centre cum Hostel for Severely Mentally Handicapped Persons

- Conduct initial and periodical assessments to evaluate the level of disability of each service user and set up an individual care and training plan.
- Provide individual or group training related to daily functioning, self-care, communication skills, social skills, communal living skills etc. With an integrated service approach, our service users are encouraged to have whole-person development.
- Social and recreational activities are organized. Other organizations are invited to visit the Centre and service users can participate in community activities and make use of community facilities. Different organizations are liaised to jointly organize community education programs and volunteer work.
- Provide nursing care (administration and supervision of medication, wound management, measurement of blood pressure and body temperature, etc.), care of daily living and lunch arrangement. Referrals will be made for physiotherapy, occupational therapy, and clinical psychology services on need basis.



*The Hostel provides occupational therapy, physiotherapy, speech therapy services and 'Visiting Medical Practitioner' service to service users in need. For details, please contact the Centre staff.

Extended Care Program

- Simple exercise and rehabilitation training, as well as social, recreational and developmental programs are provided.

Residential Respite Service

Respite services is normally provided for a period

- of not more than 14 days per stay. Subject to service availability and special circumstances, the service period may be extended at the discretion of the service unit to a maximum of 42 days. Any stay exceeding 42 days requires consultation with the Social Welfare Department. The respite service may be used repeatedly according to individual needs.

Day Activity Centre Service (DAC) only

- Service users: People aged 15 or above with severe intellectual disabilities. Not bedridden or requiring infirmary care; without severe aggressive behaviour endangering self and others.
- Service hours: 09:00 to 15:30 every Monday to Friday, excluding public holidays.
- Service charge: The Centre will provide lunch service and each meal will be charged \$20. If pick-up and drop-off services are required, the Centre will provide coordination services and the expenses will be paid by service users.

Fees

- For service users of Day Activity Centre (Extended Care Program) cum Hostel for Severely Mentally Handicapped Persons:

HK\$1660 per month (for 50% disabled adults) or HK\$1871 per month (for 100% disabled adults Disability Allowance) recipients and miscellaneous fees of HK\$150 per month.

- Residential Respite Service:
HK\$62per day (Disability Allowance applicant)
HK\$55per day (Non-Disability Allowance applicant)
- Fees may be charged depending on individual activities.

Application and Withdrawal Procedures

- Hostel for Severely Mentally Handicapped Persons: referred by the social workers to the Central Referral System for Rehabilitation Services of the Social Welfare Department. 
- Extended Care Program: no application is required as the Centre will proactively provide assessment and service.
- Residential Respite Service: apply directly to the Centre, or referred by Medical Social Services Units, Integrated Family Services Centre, Special Schools, or social workers of rehabilitation service organizations.
- If service users encounter any difficulties in adaptation or the service is unable to meet individual needs, they can apply to withdraw from the service at any time.
